Rev Nasief Kavar

We have received the news that Rev Nasief Kavar, a long time Supernumerary minister in our Circuit and a regular participant in the life of The Bridge Church, died peacefully in the evening last Thursday 5th February. Nasief died at the Horfield Lodge MHA care home in Bristol to which he and his wife Marjorie moved last October. His son Michael says that in recent times Nasief had been agitated by his dementia but had been most peaceful in the time leading up to his death. Please pray for Marjorie, son Michael and daughter Mary and give thanks to God for the ministry and witness of Nasief. We will share funeral arrangements as and when they are known though it is likely it will take place in Bristol some time in March.
