5 reasons why we shouldn't use weedkillers in our gardens...1. Weedkillers have a large carbon footprint from their manufacture, packaging & transportation. 2. Surface and groundwater pollution is caused by its runoff, accidental spillages and incorrect disposal. This poses a significant threat to our aquatic wildlife. 3. Weedkillers can damage or kill our garden plants. 4. Weedkillers can harm or kill garden wildlife, including invertebrates on plants when they are treated, and bees and other pollinators, that feed on treated plants.

5. Weedkillers can be poisonous to pets
